This cable is used to connect your FONIX hearing aid analyzer or audiometer to a personal computer.

Installation

- 1. Insert the USB cable into the personal computer. The computer should automatically detect the USB device and run the New Hardware Wizard.

- 3. Select **Install from a list of specific location. (Advanced)** and click **Next**.
- 4. Insert the USB driver installation CD included with the USB cable into your computer's CDROM drive.
- 5. Select **Search removable media (floppy, CD-ROM...)** and click **Next**.
- 6. When the following message appears, click **Continue Anyway**.
